Dubarise, from Stuttgart (GER) stand for a finely tuned mosaic of rich bass, livening offbeats and lots of love for reggae and dub.

By playing powerful songs, the eight-piece band inspires their audiences to dance to the soundscapes of dub and roots reggae. Their lyrics move between social commentary and deep thoughtfulness.

In mid-2024, the band released their celebrated debut LP "Eyes Open" with 10 songs and two dubs. The album offers "relaxed roots reggae with powerful basslines, lots of saxophone and harmonious synth accompaniments" (Irie Ites Magazine). The album made it into the top five of the "best national albums" in the Riddim reader poll.

Dubarise looks back on a successful 2025 tour with stops at the Sunrise Reggae & Ska Festival, the AKF, and other festivals, where they shared the main stage with headliners such as Marcus Gad, Mellow Mood, Queen Omega, and Jamaram.

At the beginning of 2025, the eight musicians were voted second in the "Best Newcomer National" category by readers of "Riddim." Dubarise are ready to kick off the 2026 festival and concert season with four new singles and a dub by Tippy I Grade.
